

ROAD RAGE ENTERTAINMENT BONE STOCK RULES 2021

CHENANGO COUNTY FAIR AUG 15th

BONE STOCK Road Rage Entertainment. V8 BONE STOCK, COMPACT BONE STOCK, and MINI TRUCK BONE STOCK RULES V8 CAR BONE STOCK CLASS: Any year foreign or domestic mass-produced 2 or 4 door sedan, coupe utility vehicle, or station wagon is permitted. No Chrysler Imperials or Imperial frames 1973 or older. COMPACT BONE STOCK CLASS: Any year foreign or domestic mass-produced 2 or 4 door compact sedan or station wagon that has an original wheel base of 108.5 inches or less, and originally equipped with a 3, 4, 5, or 6 cylinder engine is permitted. No SUV, 84'-89' g-bodies, or crossovers in this class. Any questions, please ask to clarify. MINI TRUCK BONE STOCK CLASS: Any year foreign or domestic mass-produced mini-van, compact/midsize SUV, crossover, or compact/class 1 light duty truck. No ½ tons. Any questions, please ask to clarify.

GENERAL

1. Drivers must be at least 16 years of age. Drivers that are 16-17 years old must have a signed consent waiver completed by a parent or guardian to participate. Drivers licenses are not required. Drivers must sign waiver and attend pre-race meeting. Drivers must wear a DOT approved helmet with safety glasses/shield and full length pants. Any driver showing clear signs of impairment by alcohol or drugs will not be allowed to compete.
2. All cars must have an identifying number or slogan (aka) displayed on each side and the roof. The numbers must be large enough to be seen from announcer's booth.
3. STOCK MEANS STOCK! These cars are to be considered STOCK unless specifically mentioned in these rules. No altering, swapping, welding or manipulating parts unless specifically mentioned. Patching and rust repair will be allowed only if cleared by head official. (ask first, photo documentation may be required)
4. All decisions of the judges are final!

STRIPPING

1. ALL unnecessary glass, plastic, chrome moldings and flammable materials must be removed. No broken windows in doors.
2. The car must be clean and free of loose debris in the driver's compartment and the trunk.
3. All airbags must be removed. Drain air conditioners and radiators. Rubber hoses must be cut or removed prior to arrival at the track. All trailer/towing hitches must be removed.

CAGES & DRIVER PROTECTION

1. Bars must be sheet metal to sheet metal. They must be at least 5" from the center of the fire wall and floor at any point including transmission and driveshaft tunnels. The back/rear bar may not be any further back than where the kick panel meets the rear seat. Front bar may not contour the body. It must run straight across. All cage bars may be no bigger than

5" X 5" except side bars. Side bars may be C-channel up to 6" or 2" X 6". Side bars may not be inside of door shell, go forward of the firewall, or beyond the back/rear bar. A roof bar (halo) may be used. It must go straight across and straight up and down. IF YOU CAN NOT WELD THEN BOLT!!! The cage and roll over are for driver's safety ONLY.

2. TWO windshield bars or chain may be used. No rear window bars allowed.
3. All cars must have a working seatbelt.

FUEL TANKS

1. ORIGINAL GAS TANKS MUST BE REMOVED COMPLETELY if not used. If the stock tank is used it may be chained, wired or cabled in two places to avoid the tank strap failure. Fuel cells or approved marine style tanks are required if mounting inside the car. No gas cans or plastic tanks.

2. Tanks must be located behind the front seat and must be securely fastened with chains, bolts or both. ZIP SCREWS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE. If you choose to use a frame for the purpose of mounting your gas tank, it may either be mounted to the seat bar (5 inches from floor) OR bolted to the floor sheet metal. (no combinations) All gas tank frames/mounts may be no wider than 24" and must be a minimum of 5" away from vertical sheet metal on both used and fresh cars. Tanks may be mounted in the bed of trucks. Additionally, gas tank mounts may not be used as a technical advantage on a car.

3. You may run an electric fuel pump, but it must have a kill switch that is clearly marked.
4. No more than 5 gallons of fuel allowed.

BATTERIES

1. Two batteries per vehicle allowed. Batteries must be securely mounted to cage or floor (no combinations). Metal frames or boxes are recommended and can be bolted, welded or chained in place. Frames are not to be used to strengthen the car. No zip screws or rubber straps.

2. Batteries MUST be covered with rubber mat.

BRAKES & STEERING

1. A working hydraulic brake system is required. You must exhibit the ability to stop. Anyone losing their brakes during an event will be disqualified.

2. Steering may not be altered in any way and must remain STOCK.

TIRES & RIMS

1. No studded tires. No liquid or concrete filled tires. Tires must be D.O.T. approved in this class. Rubber tires only. Adding a flap or doubling is allowed.

2. All wheel weights must be removed, including on the inside of the wheels.
3. Rims may have small 6" multi centers welded in. NO full centers.
