General Procedures for HOUSEHOLD ARTS – DIVISION 1

1. Entry forms for Household Arts will be accepted until Friday, July 30th.

Pre – registration is required – You must pay for your entries prior to bringing them in!

NO DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED!

2. There is one entry per person per class.

3. Household Arts and Culinary Arts entries **MUST** be submitted on a separate entry forms.

4. Exhibit cards, available at the Main Gate Office, must be filled out completely and signed. Please attach these cards to your entry in a manner that will not interfere with the judging of the entry. An example would be in a lower corner of the entry. Show officials reserve the right to move cards as necessary.

5. Exhibits must be entirely the work of the individual exhibitor unless otherwise stated in the rules and must have been completed within the last two years. Previously entered articles will not be accepted.

6. A copy of your completed entry form **MUST** accompany your exhibits!

SHOW AWARDS

1. There will be **ONLY** one 1st, 2nd, 3rd place ribbons per class. Judges may award unlimited honorable mentions. The judge's decisions are **FINAL**.
2. Judge may withhold ribbons if any entries are deemed unworthy.

SPECIAL AWARDS

1. **One Best of Show** rosette may be awarded to a **Best of Section** winner of any section in Division 1 – Household Arts
 2. **Best of Section** rosette may be awarded to one blue ribbon winner in all sections.
 3. **Sweepstakes Ribbon** may be awarded to the entrant winning the most blue ribbons in Department G, Household and Culinary Arts.
 4. **State Fair County Competition** award for a Best of Show winner in Division 1, Household Arts only.
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DIVISION 1 – HOUSEHOLD ARTS RULES

1. Any articles submitted to Classes 1,2,4,5 and 6 (painting, graphics and photography) must be properly framed, mounted and wired for hanging!
If not wired for hanging the items will not be judged!
2. All exhibit cards should state whether the article is of original design or from a pattern or kit.
3. Any identification on the article itself (e.g. sewn on name tag, signed painting etc.) must be concealed by the exhibitor.
4. **Section E: Quilting: all entries except class 23 must be quilted (no tied quilts) and except for class 24, the work of a single maker. Quilts must have been completed within the last 5 years. Please note on the exhibit card the pattern name or if the design is original. Any item to be hung must be suitably prepared with a rod pocket. Do not bring rods.**
5. **Please note: Any class that is subdivided by an “a”, “b”, “c” etc. is considered a separate class.**

Ex: Class 5a is a separate class from Class 5b

SECTION A – FINE ARTS

CHRISTMAS IN AUGUST!

Premiums: \$5.00 - \$3.00 - \$1.00

Class 0. Christmas decoration – any medium – any size

All work must be done by the entrant –

- a. Adult entry – no kits**
- b. Youth entry – kits permitted**

Original Work – no kits or commercial designs

Eligible for **Best in Section Award**

ENTRY FEE IS 10% OF FIRST PLACE PREMIUM

Premiums: \$6.00 - \$5.00 - \$3.00

Class 1. Painting any medium applied with a brush on canvas, board, paper or fabric (limited to 36" maximum in any direction).

- a. Acrylic
- b. Oil
- c. Water color
- d. Other

Class 2. Graphics: all drawing on paper using pencil, pen and ink, chalk, ink markers etc. (limited to 36" maximum in any direction).

- a. Color
- b. Black and white
- c. Collage

- Class 3. **Sculpture** – all 3 dimensional work including relief and assemblage made from any media. Also includes quilling and fine paper cutting.

SECTION B – PHOTOGRAPHY

Eligible for **Best in Section Award**

ENTRY FEE IS 10% OF FIRST PLACE PREMIUM

Premiums: \$5.00 - \$3.00 - \$2.00

*******Please note that all photos must be wired for hanging!**

- Class 4. **Color photography – single print**
- Landscape –may include people, building, objects etc.
 - Close-ups – any subject except animals
 - Animal portrait
 - Animal (s) in landscape
 - Digitally enhanced or artistically altered from original
- Class 5. **Black and white photography – single print**
- Landscape –may include people, building, objects etc.
 - Close-ups – any subject except animals
 - Animal portrait
 - Animal (s) in landscape
 - Digitally enhanced or artistically altered from original
- Class 6. **Photography – collage – grouping of 3 or more in a single frame**
- People – black and white close-up
 - People – color close-up
 - Nature – black and white or color – close-ups, no people
 - Nature – black and white or color, landscapes, no people
 - Combination of subjects – black and white
 - Combination of subjects – color

SECTION C – SEWING – MACHINE OR HAND

Eligible for **Best in Section Award**

ENTRY FEE IS 10% OF FIRST PLACE PREMIUM

Premiums: \$3.00 - \$2.00 - \$1.00

Class 7. Garments

- a. Adult
- b. Children
- c. Hand bags, purses, wallets, backpacks etc.

Class 8. Discontinued

Class 9. Any home accessory (placemats, tree skirts, pillows, curtains etc.) from an original design.

Class 10. Any home accessory (placemats, tree skirts, pillows, curtains etc.) from a kit or commercial pattern.

SECTION D – KNITTING, CROCHET AND TATTING

Eligible for **Best in Section Award**

ENTRY FEE IS 10% OF FIRST PLACE PREMIUM

Premiums: \$3.00 - \$2.00 - \$1.00

Class 11. Hand knitted garment for:

- a. Infant
- b. Child
- c. Adult
- d. Hand bags, purses, wallets, backpacks etc.

Class 12. Hand knitted home accessory (afghan, runner, decorations etc.)

Class 13. Discontinued

- Class 14. **Crocheted garment for:**
- a. Infant
 - b. Child
 - c. Adult
 - d. Hand bags, purses, wallets, backpacks etc.
- Class 15. **Crocheted home accessory (doilies, pillowcases etc.) alone or applied to any article**
- Class 16. **Crocheted afghan or crib blanket – any size**
- Class 17. **Lace / tatting – alone or applied to another article (ex: lace edge on a pillowcase)**

SECTION E – QUILTING

Eligible for **Best in Section Award**

ENTRY FEE IS 10% OF FIRST PLACE PREMIUM

Premiums: \$10.00 - \$8.00 - \$6.00

- Class 18. **Quilts – other – any other quilted projects not covered in the other sections**
- Class 19. **Domestic quilts – quilted items for use in the home other than wall decoration (ex: table runners, tree skirts, place mats, pillows, purses etc.)**
- Class 20. **Bed quilts – lap quilt, crib size and smaller**
- a. Hand quilted
 - b. Machine quilted by exhibitor
 - c. Machine quilted – long arm
- Class 21. **Bed quilts – twin size and up**
- a. Hand quilted
 - b. Machine quilted by exhibitor

c. Machine quilted – long arm

Class 22. **Wall hangings – quilts of any size intended for a decorative use on walls.**

- a. Hand quilted
- b. Machine quilted by exhibitor
- c. Machine quilted – long arm

Class 23. **Miniatures – scaled down versions of full-sized quilts. Longest side must measure 20” or less. If blocks are used, must be 4” or smaller along the largest side.**

- a. Hand quilted
- b. Machine quilted by exhibitor

Class 24. **Tied quilts – Layers of fabric sewn together at edges by hand or machine to form a coverlet; layers in body of quilt held together by yarn or thread knotted through all layers. No other stitching of any type through ALL layers is permitted. Decorative elements (applique, embroidery, etc.) allowed as long as they do not go through all layers. Any size quilt allowed.**

Class 25. **Group quilts: quilt top pieced by more than one person.**

- a. Hand quilted
- b. Machine quilted

SECTION F – NEEDLEWORK / FIBER ARTS

Eligible for **Best in Section Award**

ENTRY FEE IS 10% OF FIRST PLACE PREMIUM

Premiums: \$3.00 - \$2.00 - \$1.00

Class 26. **Needlepoint**

Class 36. **Rug hooking**

- a. Traditional rug hooking
- b. Latch hook
- c. Any other not mentioned (braided, woven, proddy, punch needle)

SECTION G – DECORATIVE ARTS

Eligible for **Best in Section Award**

ENTRY FEE IS 10% OF FIRST PLACE PREMIUM

Premiums: \$3.00 - \$2.00 - \$1.00

Class 37. Pottery

- a. Handcrafted - functional or decorative piece
- b. Wheel thrown – functional or decorative piece

Class 38. Ceramics

- a. Functional
- b. Decorative

Class 39. Decorative painting on objects

- a. Blended style – any surface, any medium (still life, fruit, floral, people, animals)
- b. Folk art – stroke work (rosemaling, tole, Pennsylvania dutch, Bavarian, etc.)
- c. Primitive style on any surface – any medium including stencil and sponge work.

Class 40. Woodcrafts

- a. Refinished functional piece – finish may be stain, paint, stencil, etc.
- b. Original piece – functional (carved, scroll saw, inlay, lathe turned, cabinetry)
- c. Original piece – decorative (carved, scroll saw, inlay, lathe turned, cabinetry)
- d. Functional or decorative piece from a kit or pattern

Class 41. Decorated Cakes - A frosted cake form, any shape or size to be judged for creativity and quality of decorations. Need not be an edible cake.
Designer's choice of material: cardboard, foam block, cake pan, etc.

SECTION H – HOME CRAFTS

Includes kits or commercial designs

Eligible for Best in Section Award

ENTRY FEE IS 10% OF FIRST PLACE PREMIUM

Premiums: \$3.00 - \$2.00 - \$1.00

- Class 42. **Soap making – two pieces from same batch**
- Class 43. **Decorative article using silk flowers – trims permitted**
- Class 44. **Gourd craft – any decorative or functional item**
- Class 45. **Any article made from any media (fabric, paper mache, metal, paper, etc.)**
- Class 46. **Article made from plastic canvas**
- a. Functional
 - b. Decorative

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DIVISION 2 – CULINARY ARTS

General Procedures for CULINARY ARTS – DIVISION 2

1. Entry forms for Culinary Arts will be accepted until Friday, July 30th.
2. There is **one entry per person per class**.
3. **Household Arts and Culinary Arts entries MUST be submitted on a separate entry forms**
4. **Exhibit cards**, available at the **Main Gate Office**, must be filled out completely and signed. Please attach these cards to your entry in a manner that will not interfere with the judging of the entry. An example would be in a lower corner of the entry. Show officials reserve the right to move cards as necessary.
5. Exhibits must be entirely the work of the individual exhibitor unless otherwise stated in the rules and must have been completed within the last two years. Previously entered articles will not be accepted.
6. A copy of your completed entry form **MUST accompany your exhibits!**

7. There will be **ONLY** one 1st, 2nd, 3rd place ribbons per class. Judges may award unlimited honorable mentions. The judge's decisions are **FINAL**.

SPECIAL AWARDS

5. **One Best of Show** rosette may be awarded to a **Best of Section** winner of any section in **Division 2 – Culinary Arts**.
6. **Best of Section** rosette may be awarded to one blue ribbon winner in all sections.
7. **Sweepstakes Ribbon** may be awarded to the entrant winning the most blue ribbons in Department G, **Household and Culinary Arts**.

RULES

1. No food items, other than canned goods, will be returned to the exhibitor at the end of the Fair. **However, the entrant may come to Floral Hall**

after 4:00 PM on the day of judging to take home half of their cake, bread, pie etc.

2. Recipes need to be printed or typed clearly on a 3x5 or 4x6 index card and need to accompany **EACH** entry.

3. Place recipe and entry cards in a resealable sandwich bag and tape to the top of the exhibit. Recipes will not be returned to the exhibitor. Committee reserves the right to publish or distribute recipes entered into competition.

4. **Baked goods may not be made from boxed mixes, premixed purchased products such as slice and bake cookies, or purchased “bake and serve” products such as ready-to-bake pies, crusts, brown and serve rolls etc. unless otherwise specified.**

5. No perishable dairy components or uncooked ingredients may be used, such as egg custard fillings, cheesecakes, pumpkin pies, whipped cream toppings, etc.

6. Classes for dinner rolls, cookies, biscuits, muffins, and cupcakes consist of three pieces. When the items are cool, place on a paper plate and put in a resealable bag appropriate to size of the items.

7. Breads are to be baked in a loaf pan, sized for the recipe, or shaped as specified in the recipe. When cool, remove from pan **BUT DO NOT SLICE**. Place loaf in appropriate sized resealable bag.

8. Cakes should be baked in a square, rectangular, or round layer pan, sized to recipe, unless recipe calls for a special pan such as bundt, angel food, etc. **Cakes need to be cool upon entering and they may remain in their baking pan if preferred.**

9. Process canned foods in standard canning jars using self-sealing lids with rings. **NO PARAFFIN! Apply a label to jar listing:**

- a. **Type of food**
- b. **Processing method (water bath or pressure)**
- c. **Number of minutes processed**
- d. **Date of processing**

Recipe card and processing instructions must be placed in resealable bag and taped to the top of **ONE** jar. Two identical jars of same product must be submitted for each entry for comparison of contents.

SECTION N – BREADS

Eligible for **Best in Section Award**

ENTRY FEE IS 10% OF FIRST PLACE PREMIUM

- Class 50. **Yeast Bread – loaf, any recipe**
- Class 51. **Yeast Raised specialty breads - rolls, doughnuts, etc.**
3 pieces
- Class 52. **Quick breads**
 - a. Coffee cakes
 - b. Zucchini
 - c. Banana
 - d. Apple
 - e. Any other not listed
- Class 53. **Muffins - 3 pieces**
- Class 54. **Biscuits - 3 pieces**

SECTION O – CAKES

Eligible for **Best in Section Award**

ENTRY FEE IS 10% OF FIRST PLACE PREMIUM

Premiums: \$3.00 - \$2.00 - \$1.00

- Class 55. **Sheet cakes – frosted or unfrosted – snack cake, pound cake, Gingerbread, and single layer cakes**
- Class 56. **Bundt cakes**
- Class 57. **Favorite cupcakes – frosted or unfrosted – 3 pieces**
- Class 58. **Multiple layer cake – finished off in any manner per recipe instructions**

Class 59. Decorated cakes – MOVED TO CLASS 41 – Under DECORATIVE ARTS

SECTION P – COOKIES AND CANDY

Eligible for **Best in Section Award**

ENTRY FEE IS 10% OF FIRST PLACE PREMIUM

Premiums: \$3.00 - \$2.00 - \$1.00

- Class 60. **Any favorite cookie, unfrosted – 3 pieces**
- a. Chocolate chip
 - b. Peanut butter
 - c. Any other not listed
- Class 61. **Any favorite cookie, frosted – 3 pieces**
- Class 62. **Bar cookies – frosted or unfrosted – 3 pieces**
- a. Brownies
 - b. Chocolate chip bars
 - c. Any other not listed

Class 63. **Candy – this includes fudge not made with any dairy ingredients – 3 pieces**

SECTION Q – PIES

Eligible for **Best in Section Award**

ENTRY FEE IS 10% OF FIRST PLACE PREMIUM

Premiums: \$3.00 - \$2.00 - \$1.00

Class 64. **Fruit or Berry pies**

- a. Apple
- b. Strawberry or Rhubarb or combination
- c. Blueberry
- d. Raspberry or Blackberry or combination
- e. Peach

Class 65. **Any other pie including mincemeat, Tollhouse, green tomato, etc. No custards, pumpkin pie or cheesecake.**
